

School Tax Credit Information

ARS 43-1089.01 Tax Credit

What exactly is this tax credit?

The school tax credit allows you to reduce your Arizona State tax liability by making a contribution for extra-curricular activities to your local Winslow public schools.



How does the tax credit work?

If you have an Arizona State tax liability (before any with-holdings), your participation will offset the tax liability. For example, if you had an Arizona tax liability of \$1,000 and you contributed \$300 to your local Winslow public schools, that would leave you with a net Arizona tax liability of \$700. Then if you had \$800 in withholdings paid, you would receive a \$100 tax refund.

How much can I contribute?

Individuals can claim a tax credit up to \$200. If you are filing jointly, you may claim up to \$400.

What are the main provisions of the school tax credit?

A tax credit of up to \$200 for individuals and up to \$400 for couples filing jointly, is available by making a cash contribution to any of your local Winslow public schools. These contributions are for the support of extra-curricular activities.

Schools that provide instruction in grades kindergarten through 12 are eligible for the credit. The following schools in the Winslow Unified School District are eligible to receive tax credit contributions:

Will my tax credit contribution go directly to the school or will part of the funds be diverted to the State or other district accounts?

100% of the funds will go directly to the school chosen.



Who decides which extra-curricular activity the contribution goes to?

You do. You may designate a specific activity of your choice, or you may have the contribution placed in a general extra-curricular account, or to a specific teacher or class.

I would like to make a school tax credit contribution. What do I do now?

Take your check or money order to the office of the school of your choice before Christmas break.

OR

- Mail your check or money order (designating the school of your choice) to P. O. Box 580 prior to December 31st.
- If you choose to designate your donation for a specific extra-curricular activity, do so at this time.
- You will receive a receipt for your donation.
- List the donation on the appropriate Arizona State tax forms when doing your taxes.

Do I have to go into the school personally?
